City Council –

Meetings are held the 1st and 3rd Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. at the North Salt Lake City office in the City Council room. A work session is held at 6:00 p.m. in the Conference room.

Planning Commission –

Meetings are held the 2nd and 4th Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. at the North Salt Lake Public Works Building at 642 North 400 West.

Justice Court -

North Salt Lake Justice Court, overseen by Judge David Miller, handles traffic violations, minor criminal cases, and small claims up to \$10,000. COURT is held on TUESDAY from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Clerk's Office is open Monday-Thursday 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The Court and the Clerk's Office are closed on Friday and Legal Holidays.

Street Parking -

From **November 1** to and including **April 1** of any year, no person shall park a vehicle on any street for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes between the hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. of any day, and during any period of snowfall when snow plows may be operating. Citations will be issued for these violations.

North Salt Lake City utility bills are mailed monthly. The minimum water bill is \$22.00

The City has adopted an ordinance restricting outside watering. Watering outside with North Salt Lake water is prohibited between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Use of sprinkling systems from October 15th through April 15th is prohibited. If an exception to these restrictions is needed, submit an application in writing to the Public Works Director.

The garbage fee is \$12.50 for one can. Extra cans may be ordered for a minimum of 6 months, with a charge for \$8.50 per month for each extra can. Garbage will be picked up the day after your normally scheduled day for the following holidays: July 4th, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. Please place your can on the curb the night before the pickup day with the handle towards the house. See www.nslcity.org for a full list of fees and charges. There is also a spring and fall cleanup. Overage Charge is 'per 1,000 gallons;' Exceptions to Water Rates: The City Manager or designee, with approval of the Mayor, shall have the authority to reduce the posted water user rates up to 50% if deemed necessary or prudent, on a case-by-case basis. Examples of rate exceptions include, but are not limited to, xeriscape or similar landscaping efforts, prolonged absence or illness, temporary indigence, and/or other cases where service is not generally used daily on the premises, and/or where water used is not generally greater than 10,000 gallons per month*
