### ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES

#### Paper

Newspapers (inserts & ads OK)  
Magazines & Catalogs  
Brochures & Pamphlets  
Mail & Envelopes (envelope windows & labels OK)  
File Folders & Card Stock  
Printing & Writing Paper (colored paper OK)  
Shredded Paper (bag up)  
Telephone & Paper/ Hardback Books

#### Plastics

*Plastics 1 (PETE) to include:*  
Soda Pop & Water Bottles  
Juice & Sports Drink Bottles  
Mouthwash Bottles  
Catsup & Salad Dressing Bottles  
*Plastics 2 (HDPE) to include:*  
Milk & Water Jugs  
Cosmetic & Shampoo Bottles  
Bleach, Dish & Laundry Detergent Bottles  
Household Cleaning Bottles

#### Cardboard/ Paperboard

Corrugated Cardboard & Boxes (flatten or cut-up)  
Cereal & Cracker Boxes (remove plastic liners)  
Food Cartons & Boxes  
Milk Cartons & Drink Boxes  
Gift, Shoe & Tissue Boxes  
Paper Bags  
Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Rolls  
Paper Egg Cartons

#### Metals

Aluminum Cans  
Steel/ Tin Cans  
Clean Scrap Aluminum  
Non-hazardous Aerosol Cans (empty)  
Cookware or Pots & Pans

\* Empty all bottles and containers of contents.

### UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Glass (any kind)  
Light Bulbs or Fluorescent Tubes  
Plastic Bags (grocery, newspaper, bread or Ziplock)  
Cellophane Food Bags (pasta, salad, candy, cookies)  
Metal or Plastic Pails or Buckets  
Food or Liquid Waste  
Paper or Plastic Cups & Plates  
Napkins or Paper Towels  
Tissue or Gift Wrap  
Aluminum Foil or Pie Plates  
Pet Food Bags  
Plastic Film Packaging (shrink or Saran wrap)  
Foam Products, Bubble Wrap or Packing Peanuts  
Bedding or Bath Items (blankets, pillows or towels)  
Draperies or Blinds  
Clothing or Shoes  
Clothes Hangers  
Diapers  
China or Ceramics

Kitchen Utensils or Dishes  
Small Appliances  
Propane or Gas Tanks  
Furniture  
Tarps or Garden Hoses  
Toys or Children Pools  
Electronics (See WM eCycling website for info to recycle)  
Photographic Paper, Tapes or CD's  
Print or Toner Cartridges  
Auto Parts or Batteries  
Motor Oil or Anti-freeze Bottles
