## Construction

### City Construction Projects Update

**North Towne Lane** – This road was recently transferred to the City from private ownership and is in need of resurfacing. The failing asphalt will be stripped and replaced beginning in late

September. The road will likely be closed to traffic for one week in October.

**400 East Waterline** – A new waterline will be installed along 400 East from approx. 900 N. to 1050 N. The

roadway will remain open to traffic and local water service should be minimally impacted. Residents and business owners affected will be notified in advance of any disruption of water service.



## 2015 Elections

### Vote-by-Mail in 2015

The 2015 municipal election in Nov. will be conducted by mail ONLY. Ballots will be mailed to voters 28 days prior to the election with an envelope to return your ballot by mail. Drop boxes will be available at the city offices during regular

business hours until Oct. 30. Two other propositions will be included on this year's ballot from Davis County and Davis School Dist. Proposition #1 is "An opinion question for the county to provide funding for transportation improvements

## Public Works Notes

### Trimming Guidelines for Street and Sidewalk Trees

Winter is coming! City Code requires that trees, or other growth, must be trimmed eleven feet (11') above the street or seven feet (7') above the sidewalk (City Code 7-1-4).

Maintaining these clearances may take multiple trimmings annually. Low hanging tree branches reduce visibility for drivers, damage vehicles and equipment, and make it difficult to clear

streets of snow and debris. Please take a few minutes to measure your trees, and if needed, trim any branches not meeting the clearance requirement.
