
YOUTH CITY COUNCIL

WINTER REMINDERS

Don't get plowed in! When shoveling, pile snow downstream of snow-plow operations. This will clear an area, or pocket, for the plow to drop the snow (see diagram below). Complete snow removal guide and plow priority map can be found at www.nslcity.org.



AVOID FROZEN PIPES

When the weather is very cold outside, let the cold water drip from the faucet served by exposed pipes. Running water through the pipe - even at a trickle - helps prevent pipes from freezing and may save you and the city time and money. Keep the thermostat set to the same temperature both during the day and at night.

GRANT FUNDS AVAILABLE

Are you having difficulty paying for repairs on your home?

The City has funds available for eligible low-income homeowners to make needed repairs on their homes through the **Home Repair Grant Program**.

Qualifying repairs include:

- * Furnace repairs
- * Water heater replacement
- * Broken pipes
- * Clogged toilet/drain
- * Leaking roof
- * Building Code compliance issues
- * Other repairs as determined by the City's Chief Building Official

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Pursuant to Utah Code 10-3-301, the City of North Salt Lake hereby gives notice of the following municipal offices to be voted on in the 2017 Municipal Election: Mayor (4-year term), and two Council Members (4-year terms). Terms are expiring for Mayor Len Arave, and Council Members Matt Jensen and Ryan Mumford. Declaration of Candidacy Forms or Nomination Petitions must be filed in person with the City Recorder's office during business hours between June 1 and June 7, 2017.



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- Hatch Park Parking Lot - A permanent parking lot to serve visitors to Hatch Park has been completed at 103 North Main St. Adjacent landscaping to the west will be finished in the spring.
- 350 North Street - In spring, work will begin installing a new, larger water line between Main Street and Highway 89 to better serve the City's culinary water needs. When that is completed, the road will be reconstructed and resurfaced.
- Eagleridge Storm Drain - A section of storm drain near the bottom of Eagleridge Drive is currently under repair. Please watch for equipment and personnel on the south side of Eagleridge Drive near its intersection with Valley View Drive (350 East).
- Highway 89 Storm Drain - A new storm drain line will be installed along the east side of Highway 89, between Center St. and Odell Ln. Work will begin in spring of this year.
- Questar continues pipe work along the Legacy Trail through the winter. The pipeline connection will be made through Ethnic Court and Skipton. Legacy Trail will receive new asphalt in the spring. Please follow signs and avoid areas, if possible.
