## CONSTRUCTION & CITY PROJECTS

- **Porter's Landing Canoe Take-Out** - Work is almost complete on a boat ramp and small parking lot at 50 South Jordan River Dr. to provide safe and legal access to the waters of the Jordan River. It is expected to be complete by late May, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony scheduled for Saturday, June 3rd at 9:30 a.m.
- **Hatch Park Parking Lot** - A permanent parking lot to serve visitors to Hatch Park has been completed at 103 North Main St. Adjacent landscaping to the west will be finished by the end of May.
- **Center Street Reconstruction** - On May 30th construction will begin on Center Street between Redwood Road and Foxboro Drive, and is scheduled to last until the end of August. The work includes widening Center St. to accommodate a center turn lane for vehicles as well as bicycle lanes in each direction. The asphalt path from the Jordan River trail will also be extended along the south side of the road. Construction will be done in several phases, so please watch for altered traffic patterns and business entrances. Access to Cutler Dr. from Center St. will also be limited throughout the project duration. Please use alternate routes to avoid this area if possible.
- **Highway 89 Storm Drain** - Work has begun on a new storm drain line along the east side of Highway 89, between Center St. and Odell Ln. Please watch for lane closures and construction activities through May.
- **Fox Hollow Drive Reconstruction** - A failing section of this road between Foxboro Dr. and the Foxboro wetlands will be reconstructed in the next few weeks. Fox Hollow Dr. is expected to be closed to traffic at the wetlands from May 30th to June 9th. Please watch for advanced notification and follow provided detours.
- **350 North Street Waterline and Reconstruction** - In June work will begin to install a new, larger water line between Main Street and Highway 89 to meet the City's culinary water needs. When completed, the roadway will be reconstructed and resurfaced. Work is expected to last through early August, requiring various traffic restrictions. Please watch for construction equipment and personnel on Main Street and along 350 North.
- **Legacy Trail** - Due to the extremely wet spring re-paving of the trail has been delayed until June. Questar's contractor is working to turn the soil in an effort to speed the drying of the subsurface so that roadbase can be in place for the asphalt. This is necessary to ensure the quality of the trail installation and ensure it will last for many years into the future. 

**UTILITY RATES**


The City has a need to increase fees and charges from time to time to provide the same level of service. We prefer to raise rates in smaller increments more often than waiting several years and enacting large fee increases. This year the City will raise culinary water and garbage rates about 2%. For the average residential customer, this will add \$.49 to the base charge and a minimal increase for usage. Secondary water rates in Foxboro will not change.



The garbage rate is increasing \$.20 per can for regular garbage. Recycling charges will remain the same. These new rates begin on July 1st. The green fees for Eaglewood Golf Course are also increasing by \$1 per 9 holes and will take effect June 1st.
