## CONSTRUCTION & CITY PROJECTS

- **Center Street Reconstruction** - Construction is well underway on Center Street between Redwood Road and Foxboro Drive, and is scheduled to last until the end of August. The work includes widening Center St. to accommodate a center turn lane for vehicles as well as bicycle lanes in each direction. The asphalt path from the Jordan River trail will also be extended along the south side of the road. Construction will be done in several phases, so please watch for altered traffic patterns and business entrances. Access to Cutler Dr. from Center St. will also be limited throughout the project duration. Please use alternate routes to avoid this area if possible.
- **Highway 89 Storm Drain** - Work has begun on a new storm drain line along the east side of Highway 89, between Center St. and Odell Ln. Please watch for lane closures and construction activities through June.
- **350 North Street Waterline and Reconstruction** - Work has begun to install a new, larger water line between Main Street and Highway 89 to better serve the City's culinary water needs. When that is completed, the roadway will be reconstructed and resurfaced. Work is expected to last through early August, requiring various traffic restrictions. Please watch for construction equipment and personnel on Main Street and along 350 North.
- **Legacy Trail** - Due to the extremely wet spring re-paving of the trail was significantly delayed. Questar's contractor is working to turn the soil in an effort to speed the drying of the subsurface so that roadbase can be in place for the asphalt. This is necessary to ensure the quality of the trail installation and ensure it will last for many years into the future. They anticipate the trail reconstruction to begin in late June. 
