

THEME: Abracadabra! Write a short story featuring magic.

CATEGORIES: There are four categories based on the author's age as of October 2, 2017. Adults are not permitted to assist teens, preteens, or children with their submissions.

- Adult (18 or older)
- Teen (13-to-17)
- Preteen (9-to-12)
- Child (8 & younger)

PRIZES: Three prizes will be awarded in each age category.

- First (\$50.00 gift card to The King's English Bookshop) - Second (\$25.00 gift card to The King's English Bookshop) - Third (\$10.00 gift card to The King's English Bookshop)

SUBMISSION SPECIFICATIONS:

- **CONTACT INFORMATION:** Include a cover page with your submission containing your name and age category, the title of your submission, the word count, and your contact information (mailing address, telephone number, and email address). Put the title and page number on each page of your submission. Do not put your name on your submission. Manuscripts will not be returned.
- **WORD COUNT:** Adult submissions may contain up to 3,000 words, teen submissions up to 2,000 words, preteen submissions up to 1,000 words, and child submissions up to 500 words.
- **FORMAT:** All submissions should use 12 pt. font and be double spaced, except that preteen and child submissions may be handwritten. If submissions are emailed, they must be saved as a Word document or a PDF file.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadline is Monday, October 2, 2017, at 5:00 p.m. Submissions may be emailed to NSLLIVE@NSLCITY.ORG or hand-delivered/mailed to City Hall, Attn: NSL Live.

CONSTRUCTION AND CITY PROJECTS

- 350 North Street Waterline and Reconstruction** - Work is almost complete on this important roadway between Main Street and Highway 89. A new, larger water line has been installed to better serve the City's culinary water needs. The roadway structure has been strengthened and will be paved in new asphalt. The project is expected to be complete by late August. With proper care the road should serve the city for decades to come.
- Eagleridge Drive Resurfacing** - In September work will begin to remove and replace the failing asphalt on a lower portion of Eagleridge Drive. The planned resurfacing will be between Parkview Drive and Edgewood Drive, to be complete in



mid-October. The roadway should be open to traffic throughout the project, with some temporary lane restrictions.
