WINTER REMINDERS

DID YOU KNOW: Property owners are required to trim trees on the parkway of their homes so the snow plows can clear the roadway without damaging the vehicles? Trees, or other growth, must be trimmed eleven feet (11') above the street and seven feet (7') above the sidewalk.



WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS REMINDER:



November 1st through April 1st

Parking during snowplowing prohibited: From November 1 to and including April 1 of any year, no person shall park a vehicle, and no registered owner of a vehicle shall allow his or her vehicle to be parked, on any street for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes between 11:00 pm and 6:00 am of any day, or during any period of snowfall when snowplows may be operating. Whenever any vehicle is parked in violation of this paragraph, the person in whose name the vehicle is registered shall be strictly liable for the violation and the penalty for that violation. (Ord. 2016-01)


TURKEYS & HAMS NEEDED
