GOLDEN SPOKE CELEBRATION

On June 2, we are celebrating 100 miles of safe, connected multi-use trails linking Ogden and Provo!

The Wasatch Front Regional Council, in partnership with many other State agencies, invite you to participate in a group bike ride and family-friendly event to celebrate the completion of the Golden Spoke network. The Golden Spoke consists of over 100 miles of safe, separated, and connected multi-use trails that link Ogden to Provo.

This free event includes two simultaneous group bike rides. One ride begins in Ogden Canyon and travels south,

while a second ride begins at Bridal Veil Falls in Provo Canyon and travels north. Riders will have the opportunity to join either group ride at multiple points along the trails for a shorter ride. The two groups will converge in the center of the connected trails at the new Jordan River Bridge near North Temple in Salt Lake City. Community events will be hosted along the way, with a final celebration at the Jordan River Bridge. The group bike rides and events are free, but registration is requested. 

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Eaglepointe Estates Auxiliary Storm Drain - Work is planned to begin in May to install a new drainage pipe to handle storm water runoff generated by the Eaglepointe Estates neighborhood. The pipe will be mostly installed on undeveloped City property but will impact roadway traffic where it joins the existing storm drain system at the intersections of Eagleridge Drive with Valley View Drive, and Eagleridge Drive with Cynthia Way. Both of these intersections are planned to close for one weekend in the coming months to allow the connections to be completed. Advance notification of planned closures will be posted on the roadway at least a week beforehand. Please be on the lookout for these notifications, as well as construction personnel along Eagleridge Drive.

I-215 Interchange Reconstruction and Redwood Road Expansion -

The Utah Department of Transportation is continuing its work along Redwood Road south of Center Street throughout the month. The final product will be a completely redesigned interchange with I-215, a widened Redwood Road, and an improved intersection with Center Street. Traffic lanes and restrictions will change from week to week as the project progresses, so please be aware of temporary signs and other traffic control devices while travelling through the work zone.
