

LEGACY SPLASH PAD

The City recently closed the Legacy Park Splash Pad for an entire day due to evidence that dogs had been in and around the splash pad. Please remember that the splash pad is basically the same thing as a swimming pool. It uses recycled culinary water and if the the water is contaminated, then we have to close it to clean and sanitize the water and the surrounding area.

We encourage residents to keep their animals out of the Legacy Park - Dogs are prohibited in this park, and though it is a beautiful large piece of open space, dogs are not allowed. Residents who bring dogs to this park increase the likelihood that the splash pad will be shut down. Please also use swim diapers for children so that there aren't human contributions to contamination. Regulations are posted around the splash pad that will keep the splash pad operating safely.

Legacy Park is a wonderful place and the splash pad is an awesome amenity. For the benefit of all, please follow posted rules so we can all enjoy the splash pad during these very warm days.



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- Eaglepointe Storm Drain - Working through mid-August to install a new drainage pipe for storm water runoff generated by the Eaglepointe Estates neighborhood. The pipe is mostly completed but will continue to impact roadway traffic where it joins the existing storm drain system at the intersections of Eagleridge/Valley View Dr., and Eagleridge/Cynthia Way. There are no further road closures expected. Please watch for traffic warning signs and construction personnel.
- I-215 Interchange Reconstruction and Redwood Road Expansion - The Utah Dept. of Transportation is continuing work along Redwood Rd. and Center St. throughout the summer, including some nightly closures of Center St. at Redwood Rd. in July, as well as resurfacing most of Redwood Rd. within the city limits. The final product will be a completely redesigned interchange with I-215, a widened Redwood Rd., and an improved intersection with Center Street. Traffic lanes and restrictions will change from week to week as the project progresses, so please be aware of temporary signs and other traffic control devices while travelling through the work zone. - 130 East Street Reconstruction - This road will be under construction throughout July but will open to traffic soon. This project will provide new curb and gutter, sidewalk, decorative concrete parkstrip, and asphalt roadway between Center Street and Orchard Drive.
