

VOTER REGISTRATION

To Register to Vote in Utah you must:

- Be a citizen of the U.S.
- Have resided in Utah for 30 days Immediately before the next election.
- Be at least 18 Years old on or before the next election.
- Not be a convicted felon currently incarcerated for commission of a felony.
- Not be convicted of treason or come against the elective franchise, unless restored to civil rights.
- Not be found to be mentally incompetent by a court of law.




CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

• Center Street and Foxboro Drive Sidewalk - Work has begun to install a sidewalk along the north side of Center Street from Redwood Road to Foxboro Drive, and northward into the Foxboro neighborhood. The project will greatly increase pedestrian safety, as there is currently no sidewalk along that stretch of Center Street. Access to bus stops will also be expanded and improved along the roadway. There are no plans to close roads or business accesses, but drivers should be on the lookout for construction activities encroaching into the north roadway shoulder. Please watch for warning signs and use caution when driving in the area. Work is expected to be complete by the end of October.

• I-215 Interchange Reconstruction and Redwood Road Expansion - The Utah Department of Transportation is continuing its work along Redwood Road and Center Street throughout the month. This includes some nightly closures of Center Street at Redwood Road, as well as resurfacing most of Redwood Road within the city limits. The final product will be a completely redesigned interchange with I-215, a widened Redwood Road, and an improved intersection with Center Street. Traffic lanes and restrictions will change from week to week as the project progresses, so please be aware of temporary signs and other traffic control devices while travelling through the work zone.
