

WINTER REMINDERS

DID YOU KNOW? Property owners are required to trim trees on the parkway of their homes so snow plows can clear the roadway without damaging the vehicles? Trees, or other growth, must be trimmed eleven feet (11') above the street and seven feet (7') above the sidewalk.



DON'T GET PLOWED IN



When shoveling, pile snow downstream of snowplow operations. This will clear an area, or pocket, for the plow to drop the snow (see diagram). Snow removal guide and plow priority map can be found at www.nslcity.org.



The City of North Salt Lake adopted a Town Center Master Plan in 2016 to further define the vision established by the City's 2013 General Plan Update. These plans focus on the revitalization of the area known as the Town Center and US89 Corridor and reflect community input from numerous workshops held to determine the future of growth in the area. These plans guide property owners as to how these areas should change over time and focus investment in North Salt Lake. In support of the adopted plans and to implement the goals of the community, the City Council has recently approved an exciting project located directly north of City Hall. The NSL City Center and Park Lofts at City Center, by Brighton Homes, is a mixed-use project, which includes a new commercial building with retail and office space on the northwest corner of US89 and Center Street. The project also includes 54 attractive modern 2-3 bedroom townhomes that will be offered for sale to individuals and families. The project features high quality architecture and design that helps create a distinct



City Center for North Salt Lake and includes the improvement of a public plaza on the corner of Center Street and Highway 89, with raised planters, seating, landscaping and decorative lighting. The commercial building is designed to accommodate a restaurant with elevated outdoor patio seating, as well as other small retail shops and second floor office space.

Other efforts currently underway in support of the adopted city plans, include an expansion and re-design of Hatch Park, many new

trail connections within the town center, streetscape improvements including decorative street lights, flowering baskets, city banners, public space, seating, and public art. Watch for future announcements of public meetings and open houses or feel free to visit with City staff to ask questions or give us feedback on the plans. Our Community Development Department would love to hear from citizens and explain some of the exciting projects on the horizon for our great city.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

• I-215 Interchange Reconstruction and Redwood Road Expansion - The Utah Department of Transportation is continuing its work along Redwood Road throughout the month. The major planned work on Center Street has been completed, so remaining impacts to Center Street traffic are expected to be minimal, involving no additional full closures of the roadway. Work will continue on Redwood Road south of Center Street, as well as the interchange with I-215. The expected completion date for the entire project is June of 2019. The final product will be a completely redesigned in-



terchange with I-215, a widened Redwood Road, and an improved intersection with Center Street. Traffic lanes and restrictions will change from week to week as the project progresses, so please be aware of temporary signs and other traffic control devices while travelling through the work zone.
