## NEW BUSINESSES




The City of North Salt Lake continues to attract outstanding new businesses into the community, and our two most recent are no exception!

Qualifying repairs include:

- Furnace repairs
- Water heater re-placement
- Broken pipes
- Clogged toilet/drain
- Leaking roof
- Building Code compliance issues
- Aging in Place and ADA modifications
- Energy efficiency improvements
- Other repairs as determined by the City's Chief Building Official


