FLUORIDE SAFETY

Recent events in other cities with fluoridated water have created concern about the safety of fluoride in our City's water. NSL City Water employees work very hard to provide a clean, safe, reliable supply of water to our residential and commercial customers. Regularly scheduled water samples test for many contaminants that would impair the quality of water. Additional sampling is done to ensure the correct amount of fluoride is added to the water as per Davis County Health Department rules and regulations created after ballot measures were approved by voters in the 2000 and 2004 elections. The City uses Hydrofluorosilicic Acid to achieve the required dosage of 0.7 parts per million (think 7 tenths of a penny in \$10,000). This is the required dosage as set by the State Division of Drinking Water and the Davis County Health Department to achieve the beneficial use of fluoride.

To prevent the overdosing of fluoride, City employees take daily samples at City operated wells and multiple samples every week throughout the water system to ensure the correct dosage. Fluoride-injecting equipment at City wells is secured by multiple controls when the wells are not running, and dosing adjustments are only allowed by a trained City employee physically adjusting the setting on the dosing pump while the well is running.

These policies and practices are just a small portion of what the City does to ensure a clean, safe, reliable water supply. For questions about water quality, please call the City at 801-335-8700.
