

UPCOMING PROJECTS


The City will be re-constructing portions of Orchard Drive this summer between Eagleridge Drive and the north city limit line. The project will be done in two phases. The first phase which began on May 13th will affect Orchard Drive between Eaglewood Drive and approximately 3200 South (Bountiful). Businesses along this portion of Orchard will remain open, and there are well-marked detours in the area directing drivers to access points for those businesses. Phase one of the project is expected to be completed by June 17th.



Phase 2 of the project will re-build the road between Eagleridge Drive and Center Street and will include new curb, gutter and sidewalk on the east side of the street. The sidewalk portion of this project will begin in June and the road re-construction will begin in mid-August and could last for 60 days. A part of this project will also include a reconstruction of Eagleridge Drive between Highway 89 and the roundabout at Orchard Drive.

We appreciate the public's patience on these projects. There will be inconvenience and delays, but in the end, we will all enjoy new road surfaces at these locations.
