UTILITY RATES

The City of North Salt Lake has adjusted the rates for solid waste, and for culinary water, effective July 1, 2019. The adjustment of culinary water rates is necessitated by rising costs and inflation. Culinary water rates will rise by approximately 3% for all users.

Due to rate increases from Waste Management and Wasatch Integrated Waste Management the City has adjusted its solid waste rates as shown in the table below.

SPLASH PAD REMINDERS

Last summer the City had to shut down the Legacy Park Splash Pad for an entire day due to evidence that dogs had been in and around the splash pad. The splash pad is basically the same thing as a swimming pool. It uses recycled culinary water, and if contaminated, we have to close it to clean and sanitize the water and the surrounding area. We encourage residents to keep their animals out of the Legacy Park. Dogs are prohibited in this park. Residents

who bring dogs to this park increase the likelihood that the splash pad will be shut down. Please also use swim diapers for children so that there aren't human contributions to contamination. Regulations are posted around the splash pad that will keep

UPCOMING PROJECTS

1. ORCHARD DRIVE

The City is continuing the Orchard Drive re-construction projects between Eagleridge Drive and the north city limit line. The first phase which began on May 13th, between Eaglewood Drive and approximately 3200 South (Bountiful), will be completed the last week of June.

Phase 2 of the project will re-build the road between Eagleridge Drive and Center Street and will include new curb, gutter and sidewalk on the east side of the street. The sidewalk portion of this project will begin in June and the road re-construction will begin in mid-August and could last for 60 days. A part of this project will also include a reconstruction of Eagleridge Drive between Highway 89 and the roundabout at Orchard Drive.



2. REDWOOD ROAD

UDOT will close Redwood Road at the I-215 intersection from 5:00 am June 22nd through 5:00 am Monday June 24th as they continue the re-build of I-215 in this area.

3. CENTER STREET

June 29-30. Union Pacific will be closing Center Street at the railroad crossing for repair to the railroad tracks.

4. STREET PRESERVATIONS

Portions of several streets and trails will receive asphalt preservation surface treatments in June and July:

June 18 - 30:

- Eagle Way
- Cuter Drive
- Hexam, Pickering & Redbridge
- Foxboro Drive

July 9 - 15:

- Eagleridge Drive
- Bonneville Shoreline Trail

- Parkway Drive
- Parkway Circle
- Edgewood Drive
- Edgemont Drive
- Edgecrest Lane

Affected residents will be notified in advance so as to be minimally inconvenienced by closures and detours (usually lasting no more than 24 hours).

5. EVENT CLOSURES

Expect complete closures of Eagleridge Drive July 2nd and 3rd for Liberty Fest events and again August 14th and 15th for the Tour of Utah.

We appreciate the public's patience during these projects and City events. There will be inconvenience and delays, but please drive safely and courteously and follow detours.
