UPCOMING PROJECTS

1. ORCHARD DRIVE

Phase 2 of the Orchard Drive reconstruction project will re-build the road between Eagleridge Drive and Center Street, including new curb, gutter and sidewalk on the east side of the street. This portion of the project begins mid-July, and the road re-construction will begin in mid-August and could last for 60 days. Two-way traffic will be allowed during construction.

A part of this project will also include a reconstruction of Eagleridge Drive between Highway 89 and the roundabout at Orchard Drive.

2. STREET PRESERVATIONS

July 21st- Foxboro Drive (Center Street to Stericycle) and Cutler Drive (100 N. to Robinson) will be closed.

Affected residents will be notified in advance so as to be minimally inconvenienced by closures and detours (usually lasting no more than 24 hrs)

3. EVENT CLOSURE

Expect the complete closure of Eagleridge Drive between Aerie Circle and Eaglewood Drive August 15th for events associated with the Tour of Utah.

We appreciate the public's patience during these projects and City events. Please drive safely and courteously and follow detours.
