UPCOMING PROJECTS

1. ORCHARD DRIVE

Phase 2 of the Orchard Drive reconstruction project is in full-swing as we re-build the road between Eagleridge Drive and Center Street, and add new curb, gutter and sidewalk on the east side of the street. This portion of the project will be completed within the next couple of weeks. The road re-construction will begin shortly after the sidewalk is done, and could last for 60 days. During this time, traffic will be limited to LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY.

Part of this project will also include a reconstruction of Eagleridge Drive between Highway 89 and the roundabout at Orchard Drive.

2. I-215 REDWOOD ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Beginning Friday, August 23 at 9:00 pm, the entire Redwood Road/I-215 intersection will be shut down with no access to or from I-215 until Monday, August 26 at 5:00 am. Once this opens, both bridges will be in use and the new traffic pattern will be in its finished state. There will still be minor work such as landscaping, but traffic should not be affected after August 26.

3. JORDAN RIVER TRAIL CONNECTION

Work will begin soon on the newest section of the Jordan River Trail that begins at the south side of Center Street just east of the Jordan River bridge.

4. THANK YOU

We want to thank this great community for your patience throughout the summer as streets have been closed for events such as Liberty Fest and the Tour of Utah, not to mention street repairs and construction projects. We know these closures can be inconvenient, and we appreciate the support you give to the City and our staff during these projects and events.
