## CHECK YOUR PRV

Do you know that if your home was built in the last 20-30 years, or if you updated your plumbing per the International Plumbing Code (IPC) 604.8, that there is a water pressure reducing valve (PRV) installed in your home?

This valve is installed to reduce the water pressure so that plumbing fixtures last longer, reduce water usage and protect your home from unexpected pressure fluctuations in the City's water system. These regu-



lators are mechanical and have seals that wear over time. Household usage, pressure changes,

age and water conditions (thank you Utah's hard water) cause the internal parts of these regulators to fail causing low pressure conditions or allowing pressure fluctuations. These

regulators typically last about 10 years in our area and sometimes require repair/replacement.

These are installed just inside your home, after the main shutoff valve. The

regulators are usually set to reduce the pressure to 50 psi. If your pressure is higher than that, check your regulator to make sure it is set to the correct pressure. To repair/replace a regulator, a licensed plumber is recommended to ensure that your plumbing meets IPC code.

How do I know when it's time to replace my pressure reducing valve?

**STREET PROJECTS**

**1. ORCHARD DRIVE**

The Orchard Drive reconstruction project is in full-swing as crews re-build the road between Eagleridge Drive and Center Street. This complete re-construction could last for up to 60 days. During this time, traffic is limited to LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY. Please use 3800 South as the best detour throughout this project.



Part of this project will also include a reconstruction of Eagleridge Drive between Highway 89 and the roundabout at Orchard Drive.

**2. STREET STRIPING**

Beginning soon, streets throughout the City will be getting fresh paint stripes. Please use caution around construction equipment and personnel.

**3. DEER HOLLOW RESERVOIR**

Crews will be working in Deer Hollow Park to rehabilitate the upper detention basin. Excess debris will be removed and the basin deepened to more effectively handle the storm water.
