## RECYCLING INFORMATION

### HOW RECYCLING WORKS IN NSL

**COLLECTION:** Ace Recycling and Disposal collects recycling for various cities in Utah. On the day your neighborhood is assigned recycling, their trucks pick up recycling from the curb.



**DROP OFF:** Ace Recycling and Disposal drops off recyclables at a local Materials Recovery Facility (MRF). The MRF sorts and bales your recyclables by material type.



**REUSE:** The Materials Recovery Facility will sell the bales to both national and international recyclers who turn the recyclables into new products.



### HOW DID RECYCLING CHANGE?

China, who has historically taken most of the U.S. recyclable exports, began to enforce stricter importing regulations for recyclable materials and not accepting some materials altogether. This has caused MRFs to use more resources in order to meet the stricter standards set by China and to look for other places to sell the recyclables to, both domestically and overseas. Consequently, prices of processing the materials have drastically increased. The focus has shifted from recycling more to recycling better.

### IS RECYCLING STILL WORTH IT?

Yes! Your plastic bottles, metal cans, paper, and cardboard are still valuable materials. New facilities and

technologies will emerge domestically that will be able to handle the material we can no longer export.

### WHAT CAN I RECYCLE?

Clean and empty plastic bottles and jugs, aluminum and steel cans, cardboard boxes, and paper. See updated recycling guide below. Remember when you're in doubt, throw it out...and maybe think of how you can avoid that waste in the future.

Recyclables that are contaminated will not be picked up by Ace. Please take a moment to give them a rinse to ensure they end up getting processed.

Emergencies and disasters can strike quickly and without warning and can force you to evacuate your neighborhood or confine you to your home. What would you do if basic services – water, gas, electricity or telephones – were cut off?

The City has put together a basic preparedness handbook for you and your family to help plan for an emergency. In it you will find suggestions for preparing your home with supplies and equipment and information to help you know what to do for possible emergencies in our area.

This year, we are also including a bike ride back to your vehicles on the Jordan River Trail (approximately 3 miles) following the boat trip. If you would like to participate in the bike ride, please drop off your bikes/helmets at Porter's Landing prior to meeting for the boat trip at 8:30am. **CONSTRUCTION**

• **STREET STRIPING**

Street striping in some areas is nearing completion. Symbols and stop bars are now being repainted.

• **1100 N CHIP SEAL**

The chip seal has been completed but a cure time is needed before stripes are painted. This will be done in the next week or two.



• **CENTENNIAL WAY**

The City will be hiring a contractor to replace the existing water line on Centennial Way from Raygene to Gary Way beginning in late Aug/early Sept.

• **MAIN STREET AT (150 N. TO 300 N.) INTERSECTIONS**

Dates are still to be determined, but the City will be upsizing and replacing waterlines and replacing valves along Main Street at the intersections of 150 N., 200 N., 250 N., and 300 N. Road closures and detours will be announced as soon as the information is available.

This work will be done in preparation for new asphalt to be installed along Main Street next year.
