## Updated Fireworks Information 6-24-21

The Mayor and City Council would like to remind residents of the extreme fire danger associated with personal fireworks in our current drought conditions and are asking residents to consider the following:

- Eliminate the use of personal fireworks this year and instead enjoy monitored commercial fireworks shows (such as our Liberty Fest fireworks on July 3rd at Eaglewood Golf Course).
- If choosing to set off personal fireworks, please use Hatch Park at 50 West Center Street.
- Police will be patrolling the foothills and will issue citations and prosecute violators who use fireworks within the restricted areas above Orchard Drive.
- Reminder that discharge of fireworks is limited to certain dates and times. (See link below)

## FIREWORKS INFORMATION

### WATER CONSERVATION

Watch your mailbox for this postcard about new watering restrictions in the City.

- Limit watering of turf and landscaping areas to twice weekly. One watering is equal to 20 minutes per station of overhead spray or 40 minutes per station of rotor spray.
- Only water between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.
- Delay the installation of any new landscaping projects this year. Also, for new landscaping, consider xeriscaping techniques or other low water use methods.
- All outdoor watering is prohibited after October 1st. This restriction will be strictly enforced throughout the City and the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District Area.

#### NSL WATER RESTRICTIONS NOW IN PLACE

##### AN OPEN LETTER TO ALL RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES

As you know, the State of Utah is experiencing historic and extreme drought conditions and above average temperatures. Because of this, Governor Cox declared a State of Emergency and issued an Executive Order to implement aggressive water conservation plans. In addition, the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District, a provider of some of the City's outdoor water supply, informed the City that it will cut our normal supply of irrigation water by 20% and will stop supplying water two weeks early on October 1st rather than October 15th.

The City has taken steps to reduce its watering of all open space and park areas by 50%. In addition, we will be putting the golf course on a reduced watering plan in an attempt to conserve water.

Please observe the restrictions on the back of this card given to us by the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District. We know that these restrictions may be a challenge, but thank you for helping the City and our region to conserve water.


