Do you enjoy working outdoors? Do you pride yourself on being on-time and safety-minded? Do you want to be part of a team that works hard to keep our golf grounds looking green and beautiful? If you say YES, then tell us more when you apply for this position! Individuals need to be available early mornings into the afternoon and weekend mornings. The golf course maintenance worker is responsible for cutting grass on the tee boxes, fairways, roughs, fringes and greens; irrigating the course and working on its watering system; sodding and trimming. Individuals will use equipment such as riding greens mowers, tee mowers, fairway mowers, rough mowers, rollers, bunker rakes, carts, push mowers and a variety of powered and non-powered hand tools. Must be able to perform light to medium duty manual labor. Must be able to understand written and verbal instruction.

Wages start at \$8.50 per hour. Golf privileges are included. Must have a valid Utah Driver License.
