PRIMARY ELECTION RESULTS



The 2021 Primary Municipal Election was held August 10, 2021 to narrow down the candidates for NSL City Council. The four candidates who received the most votes will compete for two positions in the November 2nd General Election. They are: Lisa Baskin (1,166 votes), Tammy Clayton (1,095 votes), Alisa Van Langeveld (951 votes) and Mitch Torgerson (818 votes). Voters will also be choosing someone new to fill the Mayor's seat. Candidates for this position are Gary Widders and Brian Horrocks.


2021 WATER CONSERVATION



The City understands that it can be frustrating for residents to try and conserve their use of outdoor water and still not see any reduction in their City water bill. The reason that this might happen is that there is a certain number of gallons that are included within the base price of each water utility bill. For example, if you live in Service Area #1, the Foxboro neighborhood, the City doesn't charge for any usage under 10,000 gallons per month. So, if your monthly usage is typically below that amount, then any conservation efforts made will save water, but not reduce your monthly charges.

SECONDARY WATER



The City received notice from Weber Basin Water Conservancy District (WBWCD) that it will shut off the City's secondary (irrigation) water on September 20th. This early shut off affects the Foxboro neighborhood which receives its outside watering exclusively from WBWCD. This change also affects one neighborhood in the foothills and the Eaglewood Golf Course. The City will be asking other residents outside of these areas to cease their outside watering by October 1st, including any residents who can continue using culinary water for irrigation. FALL CLEAN-UP


