

SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2021-51R Establishing Voter Participation Areas

RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the City Council approve the newly established Voter Participation Areas as required by Utah State Code.

BACKGROUND

Utah State Code §20A-7-401.3, passed in 2019, requires governmental entities to establish Voter Participation Areas following each redistricting by the State Legislature based upon population data. These changes to the Election Code were made to ensure that signatures gathered in support of placing a referenda and/or initiative on a ballot represent a broad range of residents as opposed to a small geographical area. (Note: These VPAs do not replace the precincts.)

As Davis County conducts our City elections and maintains current voter information, they have put together proposed areas (as shown on Exhibit A) that meet the State's criteria of "four contiguous and compact voter participation areas of substantially equal population."

PROPOSED MOTION

I move that the City Council approve Resolution No. 2021-51R: a resolution of the governing body of the City of North Salt Lake establishing voter participation areas as required by Utah State code.

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-51R

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
NORTH SALT LAKE ESTABLISHING VOTER PARTICIPATION
AREAS AS REQUIRED BY UTAH STATE CODE**

WHEREAS, House Bill 119, passed by the Utah State Legislature and signed into law by the Governor during the 2019 General Legislative Session resulted in changes to the election code regarding ballot propositions, initiatives, and referendums; and

WHEREAS, part of that revision included a process for governmental entities to establish Voter Participation Areas (VPAs) following each redistricting by the Legislature based upon population data as set forth in Utah Code Annotated 20A-7-401.3; and,

WHEREAS, VPAs are based on the number of registered voters within a geographical area to clarify the application of the signature thresholds; and to ensure that signatures gathered in support of placing a referenda and/or initiative on a ballot represent a broad range of residents as opposed to a small geographical area; and,

WHEREAS, the Davis County Clerk/Auditor Office, which contracts with the City to conduct City elections, has, in accordance with HB 119 requirements, proposed four (4) VPAs along existing voting precinct lines; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has reviewed the proposed VPAs and finds that they are contiguous and compact and of substantially equal population.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the City Council of the City of North Salt Lake that the VPAs described in Exhibit "A" for the City's geographic boundaries are hereby established.



SUBJECT: Eaglewood Golf Simulator Purchase

Recommendation

Staff recommends the use of bond funds in the amount of \$117,530 for the purchase of simulator equipment from Trackman Simulator Solutions.

Background

The current unoccupied office space located in the lower south section of the Event Center has been unoccupied and sat vacant for several years. Adding a simulator space will allow better use of the space while also generating an expected revenue higher than renting out as office space. The state of the art and premium Trackman System will allow for individual practice, lessons, group outings, leagues and activities during peak and off-season times of the golf course. Trackman is a national brand that is trusted and used by many PGA Tour professionals. Along with the purchase and installation of the system this purchase includes the mapping and use of Eaglewood Golf Course on their simulators. This will allow anyone in the world with a Trackman system to play Eaglewood.

As part of the cost to Trackman, they will install all the simulator equipment and station. They will also be training all Pro-Shop employees on the use and setup for customers.

This purchase has been part of the planned renovation of the clubhouse. It is on the City Council agenda for approval so that staff has clear authority to make the purchase with the proceeds of the bond issue for the golf course renovation. I have attached the projected budget for the bond issue to this memo.

Possible Motion

I move the City Council approve the "Eaglewood Golf Simulator Purchase" and authorize the funding of this project in the amount of \$117,530.00 to Trackman System.
