

2022 DROUGHT RESPONSE



City residents were called to action last summer to conserve water, and you did just that! Millions of gallons were saved; thank you! As you know, the drought conditions have not improved for 2022, and we are once again being asked to cut water consumption even further. In a recent letter from Weber Basin Water Conservancy District, cities were advised about possible measures being considered to combat the State's ongoing drought. The current reduction in water we can expect is 60% for OUTDOOR irrigation of lawns and gardens (both culinary and secondary), a 40% reduction for agricultural use, and a 10% reduction for culinary indoor use. Watch for additional information from State and City leaders as we combine our conservation efforts to meet this challenge.

RESERVE PARKS ONLINE




Did you know you can reserve park pavilions on our website? To Reserve a City Park:

CONSTRUCTION - LOWER EAGLEWOOD



Eaglewood Drive, now thirty years old, has reached the end of its life span and needs to be reconstructed. The project has been divided into two years, with the lower portion scheduled for 2022 and the upper portion to be done in 2023.

Work has already begun on the lower portion, so please drive cautiously. The contractor is required to keep Eaglewood Drive open to traffic during the project, although flaggers will be used when only one lane is available. CONSTRUCTION - EAGLERIDGE



Eagleridge Drive, between Edgewood Drive and Vista View Lane, will be resurfaced this summer. Work is expected to begin in early July, immediately following the City's Liberty Fest celebration.

CONSTRUCTION - LACEY WAY



Lacey Way, between Valley View and Gary Way will undergo a major project this year as the antiquated main water line will be updated and replaced. After the utility work is completed, the street will be reconstructed and finished with new asphalt. This project is scheduled to begin early July and will be done in four phases. Residents should expect some road closures and detours throughout the project. An informational webinar will be held for residents as we get closer to the project.



Is I-15 TRAVEL IMPACTING YOUR QUALITY OF LIFE?




As part of its mission to improve quality of life through transportation, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) has initiated an environmental study along I-15 between the US-89 interchange in Farmington and 400 South in Salt Lake City. The study will identify transportation needs and potential improvements within this corridor.
