## WATER RESTRICTIONS



Postcards relating to WATER RESTRICTIONS were mailed to residents last month, but as a reminder, the City is only being provided with 40% of the water we normally have for outdoor watering. **PLEASE** only water once per week for lawns and gardens, not to exceed a total of 20 minutes per week (per station) for pop-up sprinklers or 40 minutes for rotors. Hand water established trees and shrubs once per week, and no hosing down sidewalks or driveways.

We urge you to follow these guidelines and conserve as much as possible. The more we can all conserve now, the more stable this year and next year's water supplies will be.

## NEW WATER RATES IN EFFECT JUNE 1



During the May 3, 2022 City Council meeting, the Council approved a new water rate structure that will go into effect June 1. This new rate structure is intended to support necessary infrastructure improvements as well as normalize rates based on AWWA (American Water Works Association) standards for water meters.

The new tiered structure also adds a new middle tier that promotes and rewards conservation efforts. **The less you use, the lower your water bill will be.** See link below for additional information.

## WATER OPEN HOUSE




