NEW WATER RATES ON NEXT BILL

GO INTO EFFECT
JUNE 1, 2022



The City Council approved a new water rate structure that went into effect June 1, so you may see a change to your July utility bill. This new rate structure is intended to support necessary infrastructure improvements as well as normalize rates based on AWWA (American Water Works Association) standards for water meters.

The new tiered structure also adds a new middle tier that promotes and rewards conservation efforts. **The less you use, the lower your water bill will be.** See www.nslcity.org for additional information.

UPDATED RESTRICTIONS NOW IN PLACE



2022 DROUGHT RESPONSE

Weber Basin Water Conservancy District (District) recently updated its current water restrictions as a result of the cool, wet weather conditions this spring, and the concerted conservation efforts of the water users.

Effective June 15th 2022, watering restrictions will include the following:

- **40% reduction for outdoor irrigation of lawns & gardens** (both culinary and secondary, previously 60%)
 - Two days a week watering of lawns and gardens (metered customers will receive monthly allowance that equals two days of watering/week)
 - New landscapes must stay within the watering restrictions
 - Early shutoff of secondary irrigation/agricultural system in mid-September

The District is constantly reviewing runoff projections, soil moisture, and other pertinent information to ensure the water restrictions are appropriate for actual conditions. For more information and current restrictions, please visit <https://weberbasin.com/drought>

Sign up to get text or email updates

Earlier this week, Weber Basin Water District informed us that their water restrictions have moved to a Response Level 4 (Severe) from a Response Level 5 (Extreme). Previously, our culinary and secondary water supply had been cut 60%. This has now been updated to 40%, and residents may water two days per week.

"Severe" is definitely better than "Extreme" but we still are in a drought and would encourage us all to conserve as much water as possible. Thank you!

Crews are putting the final touches on the **lower Eaglewood Drive** project to be completed before Liberty Fest events in July.
