**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Please be advised that the City of North Salt Lake Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, July 12, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Council Chambers, City Hall, at 10 East Center Street. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comment on the following:

1. Rezoning of Lot 2 of the proposed 1100 North Krause Crossing subdivision located at approximately 1096 North Redwood Road from General Commercial (CG) to Manufacturing-Distribution (MD). The subject property is regulated by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The land uses permitted by the FAA are more consistent with the City's MD zone.
2. Rezoning of and general development plan for Clifton Towns located at approximately 2596 South and 1095 North Redwood Road. The applicant, Brighton Homes, is proposing to rezone the property from General Commercial (CG) to Planned District (P) to develop the property with "for sale" residential townhomes and approximately two acres of commercial space.


Interested parties are invited to attend and provide comment.
