LIBERTY FEST 2022



LIBERTY FEST FUNDRAISER - WXHS TEEN CENTER





WATER METER INFORMATION



Did you know that all residential and commercial water meters in NSL are read electronically each month?

Public Works staff use a mobile meter scanning unit to collect usage data the first week of each month. This information is then uploaded into the City Utility billing program and reviewed for errors. Although this process has saved the City huge amounts of time and money, the process is not perfect. Periodically, some properties do not pick up a signal during this process. Utility billing staff identifies these properties and submits a work order to the Public Works Department for a manual read with a handheld device.

Please note the recent and upcoming changes to fees for storm drain, recycling and garbage. The City Council adopted an increase in monthly storm drain fees from \$6/month to \$7/month on May 17, 2022 with an effective date of June 1, 2022. This increase, the first since 2015, is the result of a long term capital planning study designed to fund the replacement of the City's storm infrastructure.

UPDATED FEES (Cont.)

Additionally, on July 19, 2022 the City Council approved a 9.8% increase in monthly garbage and recycling fees. This increase is related to the rise in both contracted rates (8.3%) and operating expenditures (1.5%). The monthly cost for sanitation services will increase from \$14.45/can to \$15.87/can for garbage and from \$5.70/can to \$6.26/can for recycling, effective August 1, 2022 (billed mid-September, 2022).

Project: Remove (mill) current asphalt. Repair failing road sections. Complete asphalt overlay.
Road will remain open to traffic during project.

Beginning mid-August, the section of Eagleridge Drive between Vista View and Edgewood Drive will get a face-lift! Failing sections of the road will be repaired and then a new asphalt overlay will be placed over the whole project.

WATER CONSERVATION



The Utah Division of Water Resources publishes a weekly lawn watering guide that shows recommendations by county. The City has chosen to follow these recommendations and pass them along to the residents. Currently, their information guide shows Davis County with three irrigations per week. This is a good guideline, but please conserve where possible.

WE ARE STILL IN A DROUGHT. 60% of residential water use is used for outdoor irrigation. Eliminating just one watering can save about 3,000 gallons for the average quarter-acre Utah yard. Please delay new landscapes if possible and note that secondary water is scheduled for an early shutoff in mid-September.
