

WATER CONSERVATION



The Utah Division of Water Resources publishes a weekly lawn watering guide that shows recommendations by county. The City has chosen to follow these recommendations and pass them along to the residents. Currently, their information guide shows Davis County with TWO irrigations per week. After Labor Day, please cut back to ONE watering per week.

SECONDARY WATER SHUT-OFF DATE: Weber Basin Water District (our secondary water provider) will be shutting off secondary water on 9/26/22. Those without secondary water should also plan to discontinue watering on that date. Thank you.

DID YOU KNOW...

PLANTS ARE STILL REQUIRED

IN YOUR PARK STRIP??



Why do we still need vegetation in park strips? City ordinances require a certain amount of vegetation to be included in park strips to control heat and assist with flood prevention -- not to mention keeping our neighborhoods beautiful, inviting, and enhancing (literal) curb appeal. The City is taking a longer-term approach to conservation, saving huge amounts of water in future years. Grass in park strips needs a lot of water (7-10,000 gallons per season). Xeriscape design uses MUCH LESS water, with a drip system for irrigation and plants that are drought-tolerant, compact, tough, and some -- even salt-tolerant. Once plants are established they only need to be watered one time per week (deep, but infrequently).
