

You are most likely hearing and seeing media coverage about flooding throughout the area from spring runoff and snowpack. The City is continuing to monitor areas in the City that may potentially experience excess water. However, as mentioned in previous information, the City of North Salt Lake is less likely to see the damage and flooding neighboring communities are receiving because there are no creeks/streams/rivers that flow directly into the City. The two creeks above NSL flow directly into Mill Creek in Bountiful and City Creek in Salt Lake City.

The City will begin pressurizing the secondary water lines the week of April 24, 2023. Residents should ensure that personal valves are closed to prevent property damage.

We encourage residents to postpone their irrigation water use until landscapes require it. This can vary from location to location in the City; however, a good rule of thumb is wait to water until at least Mother's Day, which is May 14th. Thank you.
