## NSL BUDGET SUMMARY



## ANNUAL NSL PHOTO CONTEST





Why is the proposed tax rate increase needed for South Davis Metro Fire?

In January 2023, Metro Fire conducted a third-party salary market survey. The result of this survey determined the department compensation was trailing the market average by as much as 17%. Along with other sectors of public safety across our nation, Metro Fire is experiencing challenges in retaining staff.
