LIBERTY FEST 2023



UTILITY RATES



The City recently adopted its annual budget for the next 12 months including some utility fee increases that will be in effect for services received in July and reflected in the August utility bills.

There is an increase in the City's Storm Water Maintenance fee from \$7 to \$8 per residence. There is also an increase in solid waste collection fees from \$15.87 per garbage can to \$16.87, and an increase from \$6.26 to \$6.65 for recycling cans. Finally, there is a 10% increase in 3/4" and 1" water services (most residential customers).
