

2023 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION



You might be asking, "Didn't we just vote for City Council?" Yes, you voted in the PRIMARY ELECTION on Sept. 5. The Primary Election narrowed down the number of candidates to six, whose names will appear on the General Election ballot in November. Voters will have an opportunity to vote again for their top three candidates. The three candidates with the most votes after November 21 will be elected to fill the three open City Council positions. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters the first week of November. In-person voting will also be available at City Hall on Nov. 21.

NSL City Council positions are non-partisan, at-large positions. Visit vote.utah.gov for candidate information, or come to the Meet the Candidates event on October 26.


