2023 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION



You've marked your ballot, now what? There are three easy options for sending in your votes:

1. Regular US Mail
2. Secure Drive-Thru Drop Box at City Hall
3. Bring Ballot to City Hall on Election Day and place it in Ballot Box

As a reminder, the Primary Election narrowed down the number of candidates to six, and voters will vote again for their top three candidates. The three candidates with the most votes after Nov. 21 will be elected to fill the three open Council positions. *NSL City Council positions are non-partisan, at-large positions.* Visit vote.utah.gov for candidate information.

SENIOR LUNCH BUNCH


