

**UPDATE**

**CITY CREWS ARE UPGRADING WATER METERS THROUGHOUT THE CITY.**

- The switch only takes 15-20 min. and water may be off briefly during this time.

If you see City crews near your water meter, don't be alarmed. We are working our way through the City to upgrade water meters in preparation for a new system. The meter change only requires about 15-20 minutes, and your water may be off briefly for this switch.

This upgrade is in preparation for a new metering system with features that will allow residents to easily access and track their water usage. Watch for more information on this program coming soon!

**WORDS ON WATER FOR 2024**

**Conservation is still the Key...**

"Officials are still calling on residents to use water efficiently as the summer nears."

"Utah will continue to be one of the driest states in the country and water conservation remains critical to our long-term sustainability."

"The City is continuing to move forward with best practices to use less water year over year."

With the amount of precipitation received over the winter, the City was informed by Weber Basin Water District that there will not be a reduction this year from our normal allotment of irrigation water. Having said that, Utah is the second driest state in the nation, and we would encourage residents and businesses to conserve water every year, whether in a drought or not. Although some hand-watering may be necessary on new plants, the rest of your yard may not need water until Mother's Day, or the middle of May.

As a reminder, City ordinance states that outdoor watering is not allowed between the hours of 10:00 am through 6:00 pm ([Ord. No. 8-1-6 E](#)).
