SUMMER CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS



Construction season is upon us with various projects planned throughout the City in 2024.

Many streets will be receiving preservation overlay treatments. Although this work does not require a full street closure, it **DOES REQUIRE** that all **VEHICLES ARE REMOVED FROM THE STREET**. The City's contractors will be notifying residents when to move their vehicles.

Other more extensive projects will require detours with little or no access to certain sections of road. For example, Dominion Energy is working on Center Street and the City is rebuilding 400 West. Water line work is scheduled for 150 N. and Elk Hollow Road and Circle. Other street rebuilds include: Dorothea Way, upper Cynthia and 4000 South.

HATCH PARK REDESIGN



Did you know? Hatch Park is getting bigger! The City has purchased many of the properties neighboring the park along Main Street and 150 North to expand the park as it undergoes some exciting improvements. Expect demolition of these homes to begin soon.

An open house unveiling the design for the improved park will be scheduled in the coming months, and construction on the park improvements is expected to begin this winter. A redesigned Hatch Park aims to provide a central gathering space for residents, an unforgettable place to recreate, and an elevated town center experience in North Salt Lake.
