Some upcoming projects are extensive and will require detours with little or no access to certain sections of road. For example, Dominion Energy is working on Center Street, and the City is rebuilding 400 West. Water line work is scheduled for 150 N. and Elk Hollow Road and Circle. Other street rebuilds include: Dorothea Way, upper Cynthia and 4000 South.


## NOW HIRING SUPER HEROES

**June 24-July 25**

Discharge Hours:  
Between 11 am and 11 pm except as noted:

July 22 - July 25  
(July 24 hours extended to midnight)

**FIREWORKS ARE ALWAYS PROHIBITED**  
**EAST OF ORCHARD DR. & SOUTH OF EAGLERIDGE DR.**

As another July holiday is right around the corner, we are asking for your help to keep the community safe by sharing this important information about fireworks safety. Remember that fireworks are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** east of Orchard Drive and south of Eagleridge Drive.

Please, pay particular attention to safety recommendations from manufacturers and retailers who sell fireworks to help reduce the chances of a destructive fire or debilitating injury. Also, please note the discharge hours and dates allowed for fireworks.
