## SOUTH DAVIS PREPAREDNESS FAIR



## PREVENT WILDFIRES - TRACK MITIGATION



Over the past decade, the US has witnessed a steady increase in wildfires, and experts predict this trend will continue. Despite the \$2 to \$3 billion per year to support wildland fire suppression efforts, the number of homes lost in wildfires per year has increased by 163% and wildfires now cost the U.S. an estimated \$63 to \$285 billion per year in losses.

There are things YOU can do to aid the fire department and give your home the best chance of surviving a wildfire. See below. Also, if residents will submit their mitigation efforts on their property, it will help fulfill our requirements in the State Cooperative Wildfire agreement.
