City's Application for a Waiver of Federal Railroad Administration Regulations

Notice is hereby given that the City of North Salt Lake will hold a public hearing on March 4, 2025 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, in the City Council chambers at City Hall, 10 East Center Street. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment on the City's application for a waiver of Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) regulations related to crossing arms on the industrial railroad crossing located on Main Street in North Salt Lake. Approval of the waiver application would allow the FRA to reinstate the Woods Cross Quiet Zone. Additional information: The City of North Salt Lake has filed a joint application with Salt Lake City for a waiver of rules for rail crossings in each city which are currently out of compliance with federal safety regulations. The FRA has opened a public comment period which ends on March 17, 2025.
