

## NEW TREE PLANTING PROGRAM




Take advantage of the City's new Tree Planting Program.

Right now, qualified residents can pay just 50% of the cost of the tree and professional installation for a tree in their park strip or front yard. Choose from Pacific Sunset Maple, Wireless Zelkova, or Flowering Cherry. Irrigation for the tree must be installed and functioning prior to the planting of the tree, solely at the cost of the applicant.

Trees are limited, so don't wait to apply. The deadline is April 30th.

## HEALTH & WELLNESS



In 2023 and 2024, the City, in cooperation with Utah State University, conducted a wellbeing survey. You may have viewed the [survey results](#) previously, but we wanted to share some additional information put together by the Health and Wellness Committee.

Survey response rates were as follows: 2023 - 605 adult respondents; and 2024 - 439 adult respondents. Most of the questions related to health and wellness in one form or another, but we note that the greatest areas of concern have to do directly with air and water quality, water supply and public safety.
