



**CITY OF NORTH SALT LAKE**  
**2025 Uniformed and Overseas Citizen Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA)**  
**Official Election Notice**  
**April 30, 2025**

The City of North Salt Lake will hold an election on August 12th (Primary as needed) and November 4, 2025 to elect the following offices:

Mayor and 2 City Council Members (each office is a 4 year term beginning January 2026)

The candidate filing period is between June 2, 2025, and June 6, 2025, Monday through Friday. A Declaration of Candidacy must be filed in person with the City Recorder's office from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM at City Hall - 10 East Center Street, North Salt Lake, UT 84054.

Candidates must meet the following qualifications:

- Be a registered voter in the municipality in which the individual is elected.
- Must have resided within the municipality for which the candidate is seeking office for the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
- Maintain a principal place of residence within the municipality that the elected office represents, during the officer's term of office.
- If the individual resides in a territory which was annexed into the municipality: must have resided within the annexed territory or the municipality the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
- Pay filing fee.
- Not convicted of a felony.
- Cannot have been declared mentally incompetent.

If you are a military (currently deployed) or overseas citizen eligible to vote in state and local elections, you may register to vote and request a regular absentee ballot for upcoming elections.

When using a federal write-in absentee ballot, fill out the Voter Information section completely and accurately. Write-in the office and candidate name(s) for the races you choose to vote for in the appropriate sections.


To be valid a military-overseas ballot shall be:

- (1) received by the appropriate election officer not later than the close of the polls; or
- (2) submitted for mailing, electronic transmission, or other authorized means of delivery not later than 12:01 a.m., at the place where the voter completes the ballot, on the date of the election.
