

KNOW YOUR METERS



As we begin the 2025 irrigation season, now's a great time to check your sprinkler systems and make any needed repairs before the summer heat kicks in. In some cases, you might need to temporarily turn off the water to your property for maintenance. Perhaps you have noticed a small lid labeled "Water Meter" or "irrigation" on your property and may think this is the right spot to shut off your water—but here's an important tip: **opening water meter boxes is a violation of City Code (8-1-7).**

Each property should have its own dedicated main shut-off valve for the irrigation system (different than the water meter). This valve is the responsibility of the property owner and should be used whenever you need to turn the system off or on. Irrigation customers will typically find this valve in a purple box near the sidewalk. In rare cases, when repairs or replacements to these valves are needed and the water must be shut off at the meter, please contact our Water Department. We will be happy to assist and safely turn off the water at the meter for you.

LAWN REBATES

SPLASH PAD



A quick reminder about the Legacy Park splash pad: In order to keep this great amenity safe for everyone, there are several rules posted at the facility. One important reminder is that **ANIMALS are NOT ALLOWED** anywhere in Legacy Park, even on a leash. Why? Visit our website using the QR code in the graphic, or visit www.nslcity.org.

PROPERTY REMINDERS

Time for yard maintenance – Here is what you need to know to keep your property compliant with City Code standards.

- **Landscaping** shall be maintained in a good condition, free from weeds and grass no taller than six inches (6") in the front and side yards. City Code 10-1-42: Maintenance, Condition and Appearance of Properties.
- **Park Strip:** Plants may not exceed twenty-two inches (22") in height. Plants with height up to thirty-six inches (36") tall may be allowed when not located within clear view areas. Plants may not be planted in a manner that would create a visual barrier between the street and sidewalk. 10-22-3: Landscape design standards
- **Trees** shall be pruned to provide 8 ft. of clearance over the sidewalk and 14 ft. of clearance on the roadways. City Code 7-9-6 – Tree maintenance and pruning.



Do you have an ADU? Accessory Dwelling Units, or ADUs, include basement apartments, tiny homes, guest houses, etc. ADUs are allowed on any single-family lot after approval by the City.
