On Tuesday, September 30, at 7:00 p.m., the City will hold a public information meeting related to the Homeless Services Board's proposal to establish a campus facility located at 2550 North and 2200 West in Salt Lake City. The State's Homeless Coordinator, Wayne Neiderhauser, will be in attendance and will make a presentation on the proposed facility. He and his staff will also answer questions at this meeting. The City encourages interested citizens to attend the meeting and ask questions about the proposal and its impacts on the City.

A 10% late fee applies to utility balances 60+ days past due.

To help keep accounts up to date, the City Council has approved a new late fee schedule. Beginning with the current billing cycle, a 10% late fee will be added to any utility account balance more than 60 days past due.

We understand that life gets busy and payments can sometimes slip through the cracks, but unpaid balances add up quickly. To avoid late fees and keep your account in good standing, please be sure to pay your bill on time.

PARKING OF CAMPING TRAILERS AND RVS



- **Front yard:** Parking is **not allowed** in the front yard setback **except** on the driveway or along the side of the house.
Driveway: No part of an RV may extend into the **public right-of-way** (street or sidewalk).
- **Side/rear yard:** RVs must be parked on an **adequate hard-surface pad**. **No parking on grass.**
- **On the street:** RVs may not be parked on any street or roadway for **more than 48 consecutive hours**.

ANNUAL FALL REMINDERS - PLEASE TRIM TREES



With fall around the corner, now is the time to trim your trees before snowplow season. This ensures the plows can safely reach the curb and clear the entire street without obstruction or damage from tree branches.

Trees shall be pruned to provide 8 feet of clearance over the sidewalk and 14 feet of clearance on the roadways; straight up from the curb. City Code 7-9-6 – Tree maintenance and pruning.



HATCH PARK



We know it has been disappointing not to have Hatch Park open this summer. The City had expected construction to be underway much sooner, and we apologize for the extended closure and delay.

The good news is that work is now scheduled to begin in **October** with demolition and mass grading. This first phase should take about **3–4 months**. The second phase — construction of the park's new features and improvements — will begin in **spring 2026** and is expected to last **12–18 months**.

We truly appreciate the community's patience as we move forward with this important project, and we're excited for the improvements ahead. In the meantime, we invite you to explore the City's other parks and extensive trail systems, including Legacy Park and the foothill trails.
