EVERY DROP COUNTS THIS SUMMER



As we head into the warmer months, North Salt Lake residents are asked to be especially mindful of outdoor water use this year.

Due to regional water conditions, the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District has reduced the City's irrigation water allotment, and irrigation water will not be available until May 15, about a month later than in previous years.

Because of the delayed start and reduced supply, residents are encouraged to hold off on outdoor watering until irrigation water becomes available and to use water wisely throughout the season.

WHAT IS WUI AND HOW IS YOUR DEFENSIBLE SPACE?



A new Utah law (HB 48, 2025) requires cities to adopt the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) Code, which identifies areas where homes and wildland vegetation meet and may face higher wildfire risk. For example:

- In WUI areas, new construction must use fire-resistant building materials, and existing properties are encouraged to create defensible space and use Firewise landscaping around structures.

The City is currently evaluating which areas may be included in the WUI map. Property owners within the proposed boundary will receive mailed notice of a public hearing before the map is adopted.

Finishers who complete their miles by July 1, 2026 will be eligible to enter to win an opportunity drawing for one of five weekend adventure getaways to further explore Utah.



LET FREEDOM FLY KITE FESTIVAL



LEGACY PARKWAY CONSTRUCTION



UDOT will add one lane in each direction on Legacy Parkway from Farmington to I-215 to help meet future travel demand. The new lanes will be built in the center median between existing northbound and southbound lanes.

Construction may begin as early as March 23, 2026, and is expected to finish by the end of 2026. Residents may notice weekday construction activity, traffic shifts, and increased dust and noise.


More trees are taking root across North Salt Lake! The City's Tree Planting Program continues to help beautify our neighborhoods, add shade to our streets, and provide environmental benefits.

Residents can apply to have a tree planted in a park strip or front yard at 50% of the cost, with the City coordinating the purchase and installation.

Trees are available each year through a City Council-approved budget and are planted on a first-come, first-served basis.
