Registered voters who wish to prepare an argument for or against a ballot proposition shall file a request with the election officer at least 65 days before the election at which the ballot proposition is to be voted on. UCA 20A-7-402(3)(d).

The voting process for the RAP Tax Ballot Proposition will be the same as the voting process for the General Election and is as follows: Registered voters of Davis County and all cities within Davis County will be mailed Vote by Mail ballots 21 days before election day UCA 20A-3-305(1)(b).
