
Hatch Park - Public Open House



Hatch Park Committee consisting of residents, elected officials, Planning Commission representatives, members of Parks & Arts Board and City of North Salt Lake staff met biweekly for 3 months with the goal of creating a timeless gathering space that would give the City of North Salt Lake a sense of identity.



Committee members read the book "The Emotional Infrastructure of Places" for inspiration. This book states, "Great cities build great things and create sacred spaces, and when they do, the conversations that follow are never about the cost of materials or construction timelines. They are about the soul of a city."



The committee was presented information about the city's General Plan, "must haves" in a park, and maintenance needs. Idea Journals were distributed to each member. The Committee divided into five teams, each with a variety of representation. Teams went through a series of creative brainstorming exercises to begin the design process for Hatch Park.






