

# OFFICIAL NOTICE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION

## June 23, 2025

I, Brian McKenzie, Davis County Clerk, in coordination with the City Recorders and District Clerks of Davis County, hereby give notice of the Municipal Primary Election that will be held on Tuesday, August 12, 2025.

Voters must be citizens of the United States; residents of the voting precinct in which they are voting; and 18 years old or older by the General Election in order to participate.

A public demonstration will be held to test the voting devices and tabulation equipment being used for the Municipal Primary Election. Anyone desiring to witness the testing is invited to attend, beginning at 10:00 a.m. July 18, 2025 at the \*Davis County Administration Building, Room #202.

All eligible voters will receive their ballot by mail approximately three weeks prior to Election Day.

The Polling Locations listed below will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day for any voter in Davis County to return their ballots or vote in person. Accessible voting machines are available.

Ballot Drop Boxes are available at all of these locations and are available 24/7 until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Early Voting will be held at the \*Davis County Administration Building August 5, 2025 through August 8, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A ballot drop box is also available at this location.

As required by the Lieutenant Governor's Election Policy, an audit of the election will be conducted on August 22, 2025 starting at 10:00 a.m. Anyone desiring to witness the audit is invited to attend. The audit will be conducted at the \*Davis County Administration Building, Room #202.



### Making Selections



Use a ball point pen with dark ink.

To vote for a candidate, completely fill in the oval next to the name(s) of the person(s) you favor as the candidate(s) for each respective office. You do not have to vote in every race.

Go to [DavisCountyElectionsUtah.gov](http://DavisCountyElectionsUtah.gov) for candidate information and ballot drop box locations.

Ballots must be returned in your return envelope.

Do not sign another person's ballot envelope - even with permission.

Unsigned ballot envelopes and ballot envelopes returned after the deadline will not be counted.

Ballots must be received by an election official on or before 8:00 pm on election day to be counted.
